Therapeutic Residential Care Program

For over a century, **Methodist Children's Homes** has cared for Mississippi's most vulnerable children. During this time we have worked to restore and provide for thousands of children who have suffered severe trauma. By the end of their time with us, we hope to see that they find reconciliation with their biological families, love within an adoptive family or achieve success as a productive, independent individual.

Two of Us Program

MCH's Two of Us program provides care for young women, ages 10 to 19, who are either pregnant or parenting. Like many of our children, these women come to us through the Department of Human Services because they were no longer safe in their homes.

Two of Us helps young mothers learn the skills they need to care for their children, while also giving them the opportunity to pursue education and employment. Free daycare is provided in the home, giving mothers the assurance that their children are being well cared for and loved.

Independent Living Residential Care Program

This program is specifically designed for young men and women ages 17 to 21. Its goal is to ease the transition from high school to college or to the workforce by providing instruction in budgeting, household management and job skills so that they can live independently as responsible adults.

Therapeutic Foster Care

Our Foster Care program is made up of mission-driven individuals and families who are willing to provide a stable and loving environment for children. Children in the program are typically younger than those in Residential Care, ranging in age from birth to 18 years old.
